We need to wake up and ask ourselves what our role is in this scenario.

### LOK MANCH, SNEHARAM

A two-day workshop for the animators, coordinators and organization heads of Lok Manch (LM), South Zone, was conducted by the National Secretariat at Indian Social Institute, Bangalore from April 10-11, 2017. This was the second such gathering of the Lok Manch staff and organization heads at the South Zone level, including three units of Kerala, two units of Tamil Nadu and three units of Karnataka. The main facilitators of Wayanad, Attappady and Thiruvananthapuram Units, **Frs Baby Chalil, James Morais** and **Benny C.**, accompanied the Kerala

contingent from their respective units. Of the 124 registered participants, 40 per cent (50) were from Kerala. This was the first in a series of capacity building programmes planned after the Lok Manch Core Team Meeting (CTM) held in March 2017 at JDV, Pune. As the next step in the empowerment process, a training programme for the organization heads is scheduled at the Zonal level from June 25-27, 2017, at LES, Sreekariyam. A state level training programme for the staff of LM is planned from July 13-15, 2017, at Sameeksha, Kalady. The LM activities scheduled for this quarter (1 April- 30 June) are geared towards a State level public hearing or conference, ensuring the participation of at least 300 leaders who are involved in Rights-Based Social Work in different parts of Kerala. The memorandum, we submitted in connection with the recent LM State Level Training Programme that concluded at the Press Club Hall, Thiruvananthapuram, will be shared with other close collaborating and secular partners to garner their support towards addressing the pressing problems of our target groups, namely, Adivasis, Dalits, Fishing Community and Inter-State Migrants.

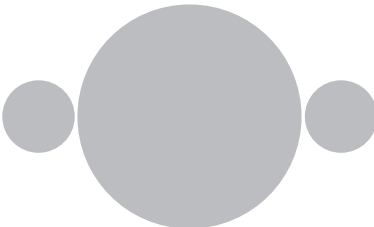
